



It is to inform you that the Vice-Chancellor in anticipation of the approval of the Syndicate/Senate has approved the following recommendations of the Committee of M.Phil/Ph.D Guidelines, constituted by the Vice-Chancellor for framing and printing of the Rules and Regulations of M.Phil/Ph.D Guidelines in accordance with the UGC Minimum Standards and procedures for an award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree on dated 30.09.2020 in which they have resolved that:

- (1) The Dean of University Instruction is authorized to allow the submission of Ph.D thesis through authorization of the candidate on case to case basis. (only during the COVID-19 Pandemic).
- (2) The authorization will be submitted through the Chairperson of the respective department/Supervisor alongwith all the relevant documents including the justification.
- (3) The person so authorized shall produce his/her valid identity card/Adhar Card alongwith an affidavit with respect to compliance of all the formalities for submission of the Ph.D Thesis.
- (4) These provisions shall not be made a part of the Ph.D Guidelines.
